

Sunranger Umbrella Ground Stake

Installation Guide

The Sunranger Ground Stake is a useful tool for supporting market umbrellas in lawns or other soft substrates for temporary events. They are not designed for permanent installations.

Important Notes:

- For temporary use only.
- Not suitable for windy conditions.
- Never leave in-situ when umbrella is removed. This could cause a trip hazard.

Steps:

- 1. Once you have determined that there are no pipes, cables or other underground services in the area, use a heavy mallet to drive the Ground Stake into the earth. Typically, the Ground Stake should be hammered into the ground to a depth of approx. 40cm.
- 2. Insert the umbrella and tighten the side screws
